The "Three Questions of Faith" exhibition asks three questions of a number of faith groups of Windsor and Maidenhead. It brings together some of their ideas and thoughts on some of the issues faced by society today.

The "Living Together" exhibit looks at how our diverse population can live together in harmony, where we can all benefit from experiencing and learning from the positive dimensions brought by diversity, and to avoid the negative thinking that destroys our well-being and our souls.

The exhibit on "The Environment" provides insight into the potentially catastrophic destruction of our environment, providing traditional thoughts on our lifestyles that may help us deal with the causes of demand and waste that give rise to many of our problems today.

The "Values for Life" exhibit explores some of the key stages of life that hold particular importance to each group, extracting moral guidance from their teachings and touching on how those stages are celebrated or handled.
